FIELD GUIDE + REAL-WORLD EXPECTATIONS

THE RIGHT EXPECTATION

Mint materially improves main-stage proximity, shade, restroom quality and onsite convenience. It is still a large-festival standing experience - not reserved seating, private hospitality or a crowd-free zone. Past-attendee reports on this page are anecdotal; 2026 conditions can differ.

WHAT YOUR 2026 PASS OFFICIALLY PROVIDES

Entry	Dedicated festival entry lanes plus a commemorative laminate. Exact lane, gate and opening time remain TBD; normal security screening still applies.
Main stages	Front viewing area for both Oak and Barrel. This is access, not an assigned seat, reserved position or guaranteed rail spot.
Rest + watch	Shaded lounge with comfortable seating and live main-stage audio/video, plus outdoor seating with main-stage views.
Comfort	Air-conditioned flushable restrooms and a dedicated festival merchandise booth.
Paid inside Mint	Premium food, dedicated full-beverage bars and locker/charging rental all cost extra. Mint is not all-inclusive.

THREE-STORY VIEWING DECK: EXPECTED, WITH A CAVEAT

A 2026 package donated by Danny Wimmer Presents specifically lists access to the three-story Mint VIP Viewing Deck with elevated, shaded main-stage views. The core public pass terms promise shaded lounge/outdoor seating but do not name that exact structure, and the festival map is subject to change. Treat the deck as expected - never as a guaranteed seat.

NOT INCLUDED - No complimentary food or alcohol; every Mint food/bar purchase is extra. - The lounge is advertised as shaded, not air-conditioned; the restrooms are AC. - No parking, transportation or ordinary festival re-entry. - No special viewing at 100 Proof, Revival or Bluegrass stages. - No chairs inside Mint, even with a Lawn Chair Pass.	LOCKER + CHAIR PLAN - Mint locker: about 8 x 12 x 18 inches with universal phone charging. - Single-day or four-day rental; four-day items may remain overnight. - Reserve ahead or rent onsite subject to availability; extra cost. - Skip a chair for the Mint plan. A Chair Pass works only in designated GA zones. - Use the locker as your fixed meeting point and phone-power base.
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RECURRING ATTENDEE POSITIVES - Close main-stage views and easier access than GA. - Shade, turf and AC restrooms can materially improve a hot, long day. - Entry, restroom and concession lines are often reported as shorter. - The 2025 expansion/deck drew favorable reports from many attendees.	RECURRING ATTENDEE CAUTIONS - Unassigned shade seats and tables can fill soon after gates open. - Headliner changeovers can create opposing crowd flows at pit exits. - Lounge chatter can reduce the usefulness of the live audio feed. - Reports vary by day and act: spacious early can become packed late.
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YOUR HEADLINER MOVE

On arrival, locate every Mint viewing-area exit, the deck/lounge, water, restrooms and your locker. Before a major set, choose deliberately: closer/front for intensity, or an edge/rear/deck position for easier movement. Avoid entering or leaving through the densest central flow during the five-minute Oak/Barrel handoff.

- Mint premium food is convenient but costs extra; its 2026 menu and prices are unpublished.
- Mint VIP alone does not provide festival re-entry, so you cannot leave to eat and return.

- Allowed: one sealed water bottle, 20 oz max, or one empty plastic refillable bottle.
- No metal/glass bottles, hydration packs, coolers or picnic baskets.

CASHLESS PAYMENT

- Cards, Apple Pay, Google Pay, Android Pay, Tap to Pay and registered RFID.
- All food/beverage vendors accept cards and RFID.
- Reverse ATM: \$5-\$500 load, \$4.95 fee; remaining value works as Mastercard.
- Cash is accepted in day-of parking lots, not inside.

ZERO-PROOF + SOBER SUPPORT

- Free water refill stations.
- Friday's Sip, Stir & Storytelling is explicitly zero-proof.
- Sober & Beyond hosts three recovery-style meetings daily.
- Alcohol requires age 21+ and valid government photo ID.

PLANNING BASELINE - NOT A GUARANTEE

From central New Albany, use roughly 12-17 miles and 20-30 minutes in ordinary traffic. Festival traffic, parking, walking and security can make home-to-gate time 45-75 minutes. PARK & TARC - PUBLISHED BUT NOT YET SAFE TO RELY ON

Festival copy says: park at 115 W Jefferson; a nominal fee includes round-trip TARC; board '#2' at S 1st/W Liberty; exit near Gate 1; returns begin 9 PM from Crittenden near Gate 4. But TARC's August network no longer lists regular Route 2, and no 2026 event notice is posted. Reconfirm special route, price and final return.

REGULAR TARC FROM NEW ALBANY

- Route 71 connects IUS, downtown New Albany and downtown Louisville about hourly.
- Standard fare \$2.25; app/card transfers within two hours free.
- Last current downtown departure toward New Albany: 9:05 PM - too early.
- Use only if leaving early or combining with taxi home.

WALK / BIKE

- Nearby lodging can walk via Gates 1, 4 or 6.
- Free bike racks: Gate 1; southeast H Lot; Gate 6 booths.
- No bike valet, security or lock service promised.
- Gate map and pedestrian routing remain subject to change.
